

Słowiński National Park

National Park Słowiński -one of the 23 national parks in Poland. Established on 1 January 1967.

It has an area of 32 744 ha, for comparison, in 1976, counted 18 069 ha.

It's located in the middle of the Polish coast, in Pomerania. It includes Spit Łebska, Lowland Gardemońsko-Łebska, moraine leading to the highest culmination of 115 m as Rowokół on the hill and a series of lakes Łebsko (7,1 thous. ha), Gardno (2.5 thousand. ha), Lake Dołgie Great (156 ha) and Dołgie small (6.2 ha)
