



Świętokrzyski National Park (*Świętokrzyski Park Narodowy*) is a National Park in Świętokrzyskie Voivodeship in central Poland. It covers the highest ridge of the świętokrzyskie (Holy Cross Mountains) – the Łysogory – with its two highest peaks: Łysica at 612 metres (2,008 ft) and Łysa Góra ("Bald Mountain") at 595 m (1,952 ft). It also covers the eastern part of the Klonowski Ridge and part of the Pokrzywianski Ridge. The Park has its headquarters in Bodzentyn.
